BABY POTATO SALAD WITH PANCETTA AND CHIVES

Ingredients (Serves 4)

For the salad

- 2 ½ pounds baby potatoes, scrubbed
- Roughly 4 oz smoked pancetta or bacon
- a handful of stale breadcrumbs
- a bunch of fresh chives, snipped
- Salt and pepper

For the dressing

- ·1/2 cup soured cream or natural yoghurt
- ·3/4 cup mayonnaise

Directions

- 1. Boil the potatoes gently in salted water until tender, then drain well. Leave them to cool slightly.
- 2. Fry the pancetta or bacon until crisp, break up, then set aside. Fry the breadcrumbs in the pancetta or bacon fat until crisp.
- 3. When cooled, slice the potatoes in half and dress with the soured cream/yoghurt and mayonnaise dressing. Fold in the pancetta/bacon and most of the breadcrumbs. Season with sea salt and freshly ground black pepper to taste. Chill for 1 to 2 hours to allow the potatoes to absorb the flavours. Scatter the top with the chives and remaining breadcrumbs just before serving. Enjoy as a side with your favourite BBQ
